Driscoll clinics in the Rio Grande Valley to close temporarily due to Tropical Storm Alex

RIO GRANDE VALLEY – Clinics operated by Driscoll Children's Hospital in Harlingen, Brownsville and McAllen will be closed from noon Wednesday, June 30, through Friday, July 2 due to Tropical Storm Alex. The clinics will reopen on Tuesday, July 6. Driscoll Children's Quick Care – McAllen, located in Driscoll Children's Medical Plaza, will be closed from Wednesday, June 30 through Friday, July 2 and will reopen at 2 p.m. Saturday, July 3, continuing normal operating hours throughout the holiday weekend.
