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Driscoll Children's Hospital receives the Texas Award for Performance Excellence

CORPUS CHRISTI – On the heels of an award for high performance last year, Driscoll Children's Hospital has been elevated to the next level of achievement by the Quality Texas Foundation. That recognition is provided when an organization receives the Texas Award for Performance Excellence (TAPE) at the Progress Level. This is the third of five levels.

“Last year Driscoll was recognized at the Commitment Level, which is Level 2,” said Dr. Deborah Flores, Assistant Vice President for Quality and Risk Management for Driscoll Children's Hospital. “This newest recognition indicates that we demonstrated with data in our application, that we are making quantifiable progress in the seven categories the award addresses.”

The seven categories are Leadership, Strategic Planning, Customer and Market Focus, Information and Knowledge Management, Workforce focus, Process Management and Results.

The Texas Award for Performance Excellence recognizes organizations in many areas, from manufacturing, to education , to healthcare, to service providers, to non-profits.
